## REGULATIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE 2019 CSMX MOTORCYCLE ENDURO JUNIOR CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP (161807/144)

**Note: These regulations are to be read in conjunction with the General Competition Rules (GCR's), Standing Supplementary Regulations (SSR's), WC Regional Enduro Regulations (161707/144) and any applicable Circulars of Motorsport South Africa (MSA) for Enduro. In the event that there is any conflict between club, regional and national rules, the national rules shall, at all times prevail. IF THESE CLUB RULES ARE SILENT, THEN CSMX ENDURO SENIORS RULES WILL APPLY**

### **1. CONTROLLERS**

CSMX Club Committee.

### **2. AMENDMENTS**

The Controllers reserve the right, without notification, to introduce new Regulations and/or amend existing Regulations. Such changes to these Regulations **shall** be issued at least SEVEN (7) days prior to the next event being held.

### **3. ELIGIBILITY OF COMPETITORS**

- 3.1 The Club Championship shall only be open to CSMX Club Members and only from date of membership. No points scored during the racing year prior to becoming a member will count towards the club championship.
- 3.2 All Competitors must hold current MSA competition licences valid for the event and this must be produced at documentation.

### **4. AIM OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP**

The CSMX Club Committee at its sole discretion shall declare the winners of the **2019 JUNIOR** Club Championship in the following classes. The Committee is entitled to withhold such declaration, should circumstances warrant such action:

- 65cc motorcycles
- 85cc motorcycles
- Ladies intro motorcycles

- 4.1 65cc motorcycles – 2 stroke not exceeding 65cc  
Open to competitors from the year of their 7<sup>th</sup> birthday, to 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year in which their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday occurs. The maximum permissible capacity is 65cc 2-stroke or **85cc auto or 110cc 4 stroke**. (Minimum and maximum wheel size 12" rear 14" front). Chassis, suspension and engine modifications unrestricted. – **90min**

4.2 85cc motorcycles – 2 stroke not exceeding 85cc  
Open to competitors from the year of their 8<sup>th</sup> birthday, to 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year in which their 15<sup>th</sup> birthday occurs. The maximum permissible capacity is 85cc 2-stroke or 125cc 4-stroke. 150cc 4 stroke only for competitors from the year of their 13<sup>th</sup> birthday. (Minimum wheel size 14” rear 17” front, Maximum 16” rear and 19” front).  
Chassis, suspension and engine modifications unrestricted – **90min**

4.3 INTRO Ladies class  
Restricted capacity and ages as per 200cc and Open class requirements – **90min**  
The winner of the club Intro class will need to move to the 2hr Ladies class the following year.

## 5. CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS

All prescribed events in the calendar below to count.

- 27<sup>th</sup> April       Eselfontein
- 16th June       Riversdale
- 24th August     Robertson
- 12th October    La Mont tbc

## 6. CLASSES WINNERS AWARDS

MINIMUM OF 3 COMPETITORS PER CLASS TO ANNOUNCE CLASS WINNERS. IF LESS THAN 3 ON AVERAGE ARE RECEIVED, WE WILL NOT AWARD A CHAMPION.

## 7. ASSISTANCE RENDERED

When a competitor has, with the approval of the organisers, assisted with the organisation/planning of the event, the penalty of exclusion will not apply. A record of the names of the competitors who have “officially” assisted will be kept by the club

## 8. RACE DURATION

Race duration will be:
