REGULATIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE 2020 CSMX MOTORCYCLE ENDURO JUNIOR CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

Note: These regulations are to be read in conjunction with the General Competition Rules (GCR's) and Standing Supplementary Regulations (SSR's) and WC/23 any Applicable Circulars of Motorsport South Africa for Enduro. In the event that there is any conflict between club, regional and national rules, the national rules shall, at all times prevail, IF THESE CLUB RULES ARE SILENT, THEN CSMX ENDURO SENIORS RULES WILL APPLY

1. CONTROLLERS

CSMX Club Committee.

2. AMENDMENTS

The Controllers reserve the right, without notification, to introduce new Regulations and/or amend existing Regulations. ONLY Club members will score points in this championship. Such changes to these Regulations <u>shall</u> be issued at least SEVEN (7) days prior to the next event being held

3. AIM OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP

The CSMX Club Committee at it's sole discretion shall declare the winners of the **2019** JUNIOR Club Championship in the following classes. The Committee is entitled to withhold such declaration, should circumstances warrant such action:

- 65cc motorcycles
- 85cc motorcycles

65cc motorcycles – 2 stroke not exceeding 65cc

Open to competitors from the year of their 7th birthday, to 31st December of the year in which their 12th birthday occurs. The maximum permissible capacity is 65cc 2-stroke or 85cc auto and 110 4 stroke (Minimum and maximum wheel size 12" rear 14" front). Chassis, suspension and engine modifications unrestricted. – 90min

85cc motorcycles – 2 stroke not exceeding 85cc

Open to competitors from the year of their δ^{th} birthday, to 31st December of the year in which their 15th birthday occurs. The maximum permissible capacity is 105cc 2-stroke or 150cc 4-stroke. (Minimum wheel size 14" rear 17" front, Maximum 16" rear and 19" front).

Chassis, suspension and engine modifications unrestricted- 90min

Competitors may not compete in more than one Club Class

MINIMUM OF 3 COMPETITORS PER CLASS TO ANNOUNCE CLASS WINNERS: IF LESS THAT 3 ON AVERAGE ARE RECEIVED, WE WILL NOT AWARD A CHAMPION

6. ASSISTANCE RENDERED

When a competitor has, with the approval of the organisers, assisted with the organisation/planning of the event, the penalty of exclusion will not apply. A record of the names of the competitors who have "officially" assisted will be kept by the club

7. RACE DURATION

Race duration will be:

65cc motorcycles

- Approx 10km of route with a 90min max race period
- 85cc motorcycles Approx 10km of route with a 90min max race period
 - Approx 10km of route with a 90min max race period
