TIMBERLAND NATIONAL/REGIONAL/INTER PROVINCIAL/CLUB - 20 SEPTEMBER 2020

COVID-19

- With Covid-19 the new process is new to all of us and riders must please be patient and respect the Officials at all times as we are also still learning.
- Riders, Crew and Family Members must adhere to Covid19 Operational Plan at all time (crew may not leave their pits crew may not hang around the start/finish and race control area), they are to wear their masks at all times and adhere to social distancing of 1.5m.

ENTRY INTO EVENT:

DRIVE THROUGH SCREENING: Riders and pit crew will be screened and temperatures taken at the
entry to the event. Your names will be on the list from the ONLINE forms that you would have
been completed. IF you have not completed the online Covid screening form you will need to login
to the link and complete it before your enter.

GENERAL:

• Entries close at 10H00 SHARP on Friday 18 September 2020 - the Start List will be posted onto Race Control and the Whatsapp group after 18H00.

RACE CONTROL:

- Proceed from screening to documentation where the race secretary will check your entries, payment and MSA LICENSE - NO LICENSE NO RACE
- Riders that do not have race tags can purchase tags at Race Control.

RIDERS TO PLEASE ENSURE THAT THEY HAVE REMOVE ANY OLD TAGS (ie; Roof Tags) we had major issues at the last event with a lot of riders who had 2 tags with different numbers. Riders please check your bikes as well for old tags. This causes major problems for the timekeepers and disrupts the live race results.

- There will be clock cards used in this race so please remember to bring your clock card holders. It is the riders responsibility to ensure that all stamps are on the clock card take a second and make sure that you have stamped correctly. The following penalties apply regarding stampers:
 - > 60 min for 1 missing checkpoint
 - > Exclusion for 2nd missing checkpoint
 - > 1 Lap penalty for lost card

SCRUITENEERING:

- Riders doing the sighting lap and the Junior Riders will need to have their bikes in *Parc Ferme* between 07h00 and 08h00 for scruiteneering and race tag checks.
- Riders not doing the sighting lap must have their bikes in *Parc Ferme* between 09h00 and 10h00 for scruiteneering and race tag checks.
- Riders need to ensure that they have their GPS mounted on their handle bars and medical kits in order and on them (see 2020 MSA NATIONAL ENDURO STANDING REGS D (9) g). (Crew may not accompany their rider to scruiteneering).

RACE INFORMATION:

- There will be a decontrol of 10 minutes after the first rider has completed his 2nd lap.
- A Marshall will be designated to collecting and handing out the clock cards after each lap, PLEASE BE PATIENT WITH THE CLOCK CARD MARSHALL.
- Once you have finished your race please complete the Incident Report Form at Race Control, pack up and leave.
- There will be no prize giving (Electronic Trophies will be sent to the Top 3 Riders of each championship class).
- Any protest must be done electronically.

RESULTS:

- 1 Hour after the last finisher posting of provisional results. Results will be available of Race Control.
- Results will remain provisional on Race Control until Monday DO NOT DELETE YOUR GPS TRACKS
 as we may call for them. If we call for your GPS and the tracks have been deleted you will be given
 the penalty. (see 2020 MSA NATIONAL ENDURO STANDING REGS D(2) D-F).
